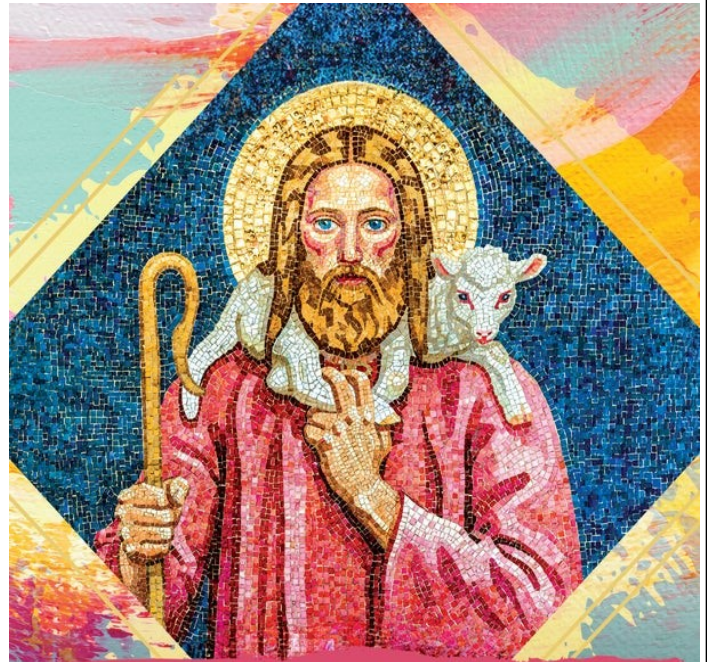

**PASTORS PONDERINGS**

Dear Parishioners,

For the last three Sundays, our Liturgy has been focused on the proclaiming Jesus' Resurrection. This the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter, the Liturgy turns a page.

This Sunday, popularly known as Good Shepherd Sunday, we hear Jesus identifying himself as The Good Shepherd who lays down his life for his sheep.

It's a lovely image and it reminds us that though all of us hopefully are trying to live ever more Christ-like lives, that it is He who ultimately does not disappoint, it is He, who really goes to out look for us when we find ourselves lost or in danger, that it is He who has laid down his life for us, so that we may be saved, that is be in forever relationship with God.

It's again a lovely image, and can hopefully get us past any disappointments that we may have with the brothers and sisters around us, we are assured that God cares.

That said, the image ought to challenge anyone in position of leadership to try to also sacrifice oneself for the weak and for the lost.

Since coming here, I've spent a good deal of time reflecting on the Parable of the Lost Sheep and its implications. Prior to coming here, I honestly never thought what the 99 other sheep who weren't lost thought about the Pastor leaving them to seek out the lost one.

Perhaps they didn't notice, perhaps they didn't care, perhaps they were angry. One does not know.

But it is a testament at least of God's love, that Jesus as the Good Shepherd proves willing to leave the 99 sheep who are okay / safe to look for the one who is not.

My guess has been that most of us were probably "the good kids" in our families, and we've all resented at least a little our parents' attention to the sibling that was causing the most trouble.

And yet perhaps we are the ones capable of understanding best that love of our parents for the troublesome one, the love of the Good Shepherd for the Lost Sheep is testament of God's love for all of us. We can be assured that God would look for us as well.

Happy Good Shepherd Sunday!

Por los últimos tres Domingos, la Liturgia se ha centrado en proclamar la Resurrección de Jesús. Este cuarto Domingo de Pascua, la Liturgia da vuelta a la página.

Este Domingo, conocido popularmente como Domingo del Buen Pastor, escuchamos a Jesús identificarse como El Buen Pastor que da su vida por sus ovejas.

Es una imagen hermosa y nos recuerda que aunque esperemos que todos nosotros estamos tratando de vivir una vida cada vez más parecida a la de Cristo, es Él quien no decepciona, es Él quien realmente sale a buscarnos cuando nos encontramos nosotros mismos perdidos o en peligro, que es Él quien ha dado su vida por nosotros, para que seamos salvados, es decir, que estemos en relación eterna con Dios.

De nuevo es una imagen hermosa y puede ayudarnos a superar cualquier decepción que podamos tener con los hermanos(as) que nos rodean; estamos seguros de que a Dios le importa.

Dicho esto, la imagen debería desafiar a cualquiera en posición de liderazgo a tratar de sacrificarse también por los necesitados y los perdidos.

Desde que llegué aquí, he pasado mucho tiempo reflexionando sobre la Parábola de la Oveja perdida y sus implicaciones. Antes de venir aquí, honestamente, nunca pensé lo que pensaban las otras 99 ovejas que no estaban perdidas acerca de que el pastor las dejó para buscar a la perdida.

Quizás no se dieron cuenta, quizás no les importó, quizás estaban enojadas. No sabemos.

Pero es un testimonio al menos del amor de Dios, que Jesús, como Buen Pastor, se muestra dispuesto a dejar las 99 ovejas que están bien/seguras para buscar a la que no lo está.

Supongo que la mayoría de nosotros éramos probablemente "los hijos buenos" de nuestras familias, y a todos nos ha molestado al menos un poco la atención de nuestros padres hacia el hermano que estaba causando más problemas.

Y sin embargo quizás seamos nosotros los capaces de comprender mejor que ese amor de nuestros padres por el problemático, el amor del Buen Pastor por la oveja perdida es testimonio del amor de Dios por todos nosotros. Podemos quedar seguros de que Dios nos buscará a nosotros también.
