PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

While it does not happen every year, since the transference of the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord from “Ascension Thursday” to Sunday, it does happen occasionally that this Feast Day falls on the same day as Mothers’ Day.

And I don’t necessarily see that as a bad thing.

The Feast of the Ascension reminds us of God’s original plan for humanity: Yes, God created us; yes, He does want a relationship with us; yes, He invites us to collaborate with Him in the creation of a just and perfect world. However, He also lets us be and respects our freedom, perhaps even to an extreme.

In the Bible, we read that God created the whole world in six days, on the last day, creating us. And then He rested. We also read that God enjoyed coming down in the evening to take a walk with his creations, Adam and Eve. He didn’t put a lot of demands on them. He just enjoyed walking with them.

After they first sinned, the whole project of creation was thrown into jeopardy. However, God patiently over thousands of years pieced everything together and sent His son, Jesus, on a “service call” to definitively fix it. And after waiting three days after his crucifixion for the world to reboot and waiting around 40 more days to make sure that “all was well,” He happily returned back to the heavens confident that He could leave his beloved creations, us, alone to finish the work that He had started.

Now what can this teach our mothers who we honor today?

For all of my priesthood, I’ve written and preached lovely testimonies of the love and power of moms. This year, inspired by the Scriptures we hear and the Feast Day we celebrate I feel called to do something else.

We all love our moms. Our Mothers are generally our biggest defenders. But it’s probably not an accident that in the recent decades the term “helicopter parents” and then especially “helicopter mothers” was born. Yet, if God is confident in his creations, then perhaps our moms should be confident as well. Let our children breathe a little and even fail a little. For that’s all part of learning as well!

But I still say all this in love and Happy Mothers Day to all!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

Es cierto que no sucede todos los años, pero desde la transferencia de la Fiesta de la Ascensión del Señor del “Jueves de la Ascensión” al Domingo, a veces esta Fiesta cae el mismo día que el Día de las Madres.

Y no lo veo necesariamente como algo malo.

La Fiesta de la Ascensión nos recuerda el plan original de Dios para la humanidad: Sí, Dios nos creó; sí, él quiere una relación con nosotros, sí, nos invita a colaborar con él en la creación de un mundo justo y perfecto. Pero, él también nos deja en paz, y respeta nuestra libertad, hasta el extremo.

Dejemos que nuestros hijos respiren un poco e incluso fracasen un poco. ¡Porque todo eso también es parte del aprendizaje!

Pero sigo diciendo todo esto con mucho cariño y ¡Feliz Día de las Madres a todas!

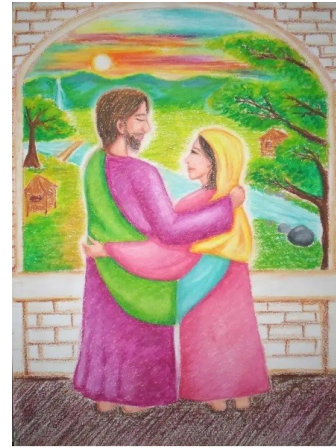
