PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

The Sunday Readings this time of year are intended to be contemplated in a more restful state, relaxing perhaps in a chair at the end of the day looking toward a park or garden and the horizon beyond.

The questions that the Readings raise are not necessarily easy ones but they are intended to be reflected upon now, during the summer, with a certain degree of tranquility, that in the end God is in charge.

The First Reading this Sunday from the Book of Wisdom tells us that we were not intended for suffering and death, that this was not part of the original plan. Yet, both are of course part of our lives.

And the Gospel Reading recounts a quite challenging day in this regard in Jesus' Pastoral Ministry – first being asked by a local synagogue official to attend to his gravely ill daughter, and then at least briefly interrupted in his journey there by the needs of a similarly ailing elderly woman.

Indeed, I have found over that course of my 25 years of Ministry that a good part of Pastoral Ministry and of seeking to live a Christian life, is to be frequently interrupted or otherwise distracted by people who on the face of it can be “annoying” us, but clearly are in need of our help, or at least to be assured that they are not alone and that they are loved.

Over these years I have found that while Religious Life and or Priesthood is “outside the norm” of everyday life, it is overwhelmingly fulfilling. Years ago, I have found Jesus' promise that everyone who gives up anything for his sake will be rewarded 100 fold to be absolutely true.

I know that the question of celibacy has often been the principal obstacle keeping people of our day from entering into religious life. But it is honestly a shame. Even married people need to be exclusive to their partners, and need to then care for their families.

In my life, I count the number of people that I have met, the number of remarkable situations that I have found myself in as a result of my saying yes to this style of ministry and I have to say that if I were to complain, I'd have to be wildly ungrateful for all that I have received.

And I do hope that I've been a person expression of faith has proven hard to forget and perhaps that grudgingly we can come all to see that the people who most annoy us can become invitations to see the presence of God and his action in the world in ways that we never would have thought possible before.

Thank you God and thank you all for these 25 years!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

Las lecturas Dominicales en esta parte del año se deben ser contempladas con cierta tranquilidad quizás en sentados una silla al final del día mirando hacia un parque o jardín y el horizonte más allá.

Las preguntas que ofrecen las Lecturas no son necesariamente fáciles pero pretenden ser reflexionadas ahora, durante el verano, con cierta tranquilidad, de que al final Dios es en control.

La Primera Lectura de este Domingo del Libro de la Sabiduría nos dice que no estábamos destinados por el sufrimiento y la muerte, que esto no era parte del plan original. Sin embargo, ambos hacen parte de nuestras vidas ahora.

Y la lectura del Evangelio relata un día desafiante a este respecto en el ministerio pastoral de Jesús: primero, un oficial de la sinagoga local le pidió que atendiera a su hija gravemente enferma, y luego, al menos brevemente, fue interrumpido en su camino hasta allí por las necesidades de otra persona en ese caso anciana enferma también.

De hecho, he descubierto a lo largo de mis 25 años de ministerio que una buena parte del ministerio pastoral y, de buscar vivir una vida Cristiana, debe ser frecuentemente interrumpida o distraída de alguna u otra manera por personas que, a primera vista, pueden parecer “problemáticos”, pero claramente necesitan nuestra ayuda, o al menos que se les asegure que no están solos y que son amados.

A lo largo de estos años he descubierto que, si bien la vida religiosa o el sacerdocio están “fuera de la norma” de la vida cotidiana, son abrumadoramente satisfactorios. Hace años, descubrí que la promesa de Jesús de que todo aquel que renuncie a cualquier cosa por Él será recompensado 100 veces mayor es absolutamente cierta.

Sé que la cuestión del celibato ha sido a menudo el principal obstáculo que impide a la gente de nuestros días entrar en la vida religiosa. Pero sinceramente es una pena. Incluso las personas casadas deben ser exclusivas de sus parejas y luego cuidar de sus familias.

En mi vida, cuento la cantidad de personas que he conocido, la cantidad de situaciones inolvidables en las que me he encontrado como resultado de haber dicho sí a este estilo de ministerio y tengo que decir que si me quejara, tendría que ser tremendamente desagradecido por todo lo que he recibido.

Y espero que haya sido una persona cuya expresión de fe haya resultado difícil de olvidar y tal vez que aun las personas que nos molestan pueden convertirse en invitaciones a ver la presencia de Dios y su acción en el mundo de una manera que nunca antes hubieramos creído posible.

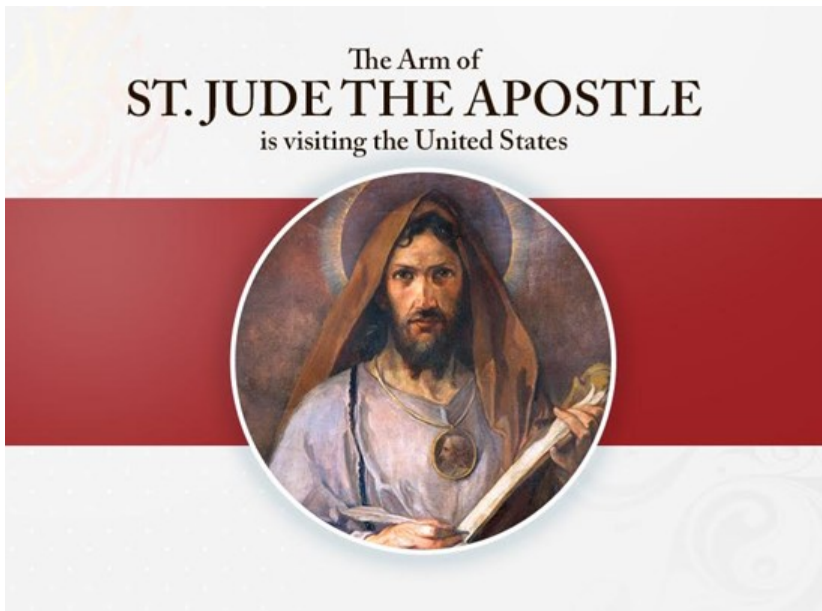
