PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

In this last month of the Liturgical Year, before we “turn the page” to a new one again, we are reminded this Sunday of the two Commandments that are the most important:

(1) Love God, with all one’s soul, mind and strength, and (2) to love one’s neighbor as oneself.

A number of years back, when Rabbi Nico was here to give our Lenten Mission, he told us that a number of Rabbis had questions about the second, not that it is not important to love beyond one oneself, but that “neighbors often look and sound like ourselves.”

To this end, Jesus made his own clarification, giving us the Parable of the Good Samaritan to explain who a good neighbor is, (1) not merely one of our own, and (2) one willing to help someone in need who one does not even know.

And indeed, next week, we’ll get another clarification, consistent with the theme of Mark’s Gospel – that one’s neighbor is often the one we do not see ... like the widow putting her two little coins into the collection box.

We are a few days from yet another significant election in our country. And as elections go, one side will, of course, lose.

Yet it would be useful to remember that Jesus, as the messiah, came to Israel, after it had lost, indeed lost, many, many times.

I do not look forward to the prospect that after nearly 250 years, it would be my generation that would somehow throw away democracy.

But for years, I’ve also appreciated that when Jesus came, he didn’t interest himself in the politics of his time. And perhaps the lesson of our last generation has been that interest in justice in this world really is crushingly burdensome.

Perhaps the Good News is that God doesn’t care who’s “in charge” here, that God’s instead interested simply IN US, in ALL OF US and that we have full lives often despite whoever is “in charge.”

The coming years may be quite awful, but Jesus came into this world in a quite awful time, and the Church since has survived in other quite awful times.

And yet we can always reach out to the person beyond us, asking for a little help, and thus make the world a little better for all for all of us,

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

En este último mes del Año Litúrgico, antes de “pasar página” a una nueva, este domingo se nos recuerdan los dos Mandamientos más importantes:

(1) Amar a Dios con toda el alma, mente y fuerzas, y (2) amar al prójimo como a uno mismo.

Hace unos años, cuando el rabino Nico estuvo aquí para dar nuestra misión de Cuaresma, nos dijo que varios rabinos tenían preguntas sobre el segundo, no que no sea importante amar más allá de uno mismo, sino que “los vecinos a menudo miran y suenan como nosotros mismos”.

Por su parte, Jesús hizo su propia aclaración, dándonos la parábola del Buen Samaritano para explicar quién es un buen prójimo, (1) no simplemente uno de los nuestros, y (2) uno dispuesto a ayudar al necesitado quien no conoce.

Y de hecho, la próxima semana tendremos otra aclaración, consistente con el tema del Evangelio de Marcos: que el prójimo es a menudo el que no vemos... como la viuda que pone sus dos moneditas en la caja de colecta.

Estamos a unos días de otra elección importante en nuestro país. Y a medida que avancen las elecciones, un lado, por supuesto, debe perder.

Sin embargo, sería útil recordar que Jesús, como Mesías, vino a Israel después de que ese país se había perdido, de hecho perdido, muchas, muchas veces.

No espero con gran alegría la perspectiva de que después de casi 250 años sea mi generación la que de algún modo deseche la democracia.

Pero por años, he apreciado que cuando Jesús vino, no se interesó en la política de su época. Y tal vez la lección de nuestra última generación haya sido que el interés por la justicia en este mundo es realmente un peso insoportable.

Quizás la buena noticia es que a Dios no le importa quién está “a cargo” aquí, que en cambio Dios está interesado simplemente en NOSOTROS, en TODOS NOSOTROS y que tenemos vidas plenas a menudo a pesar de quien esté “a cargo”.

Los años que vienen pueden ser bastante terribles, pero Jesús vino a este mundo en una época ya terrible, y desde entonces la Iglesia ha sobrevivido en otras épocas bastante terribles.

Pero siempre podemos acercarnos a la persona que está más allá de nosotros, quien nos pide por un poco de ayuda y así hacer que el mundo sea un poco mejor para todos nosotros.
