PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

We find ourselves in Autumn, and as I have written before, this part of the Liturgical Year is quite challenging.

The Sunday Readings this year are generally built around passages coming from the Gospel of Mark, and they repeatedly remind us that God's perspective is different than that of the world, and that often enough those who think that they see clearly do not, and those at the margins, often dismissed, actually see more clearly than we do:

So today we hear the famous passage in which two of Jesus' first four disciples – James and John, the Sons of Zebedee – come to Jesus with a somewhat arrogant request: that when Jesus enters his glory, they get to sit at his right hand and at his left.

It has been noted over the ages, that since James and John are often referred to as “the Sons of Zebedee” that Zebedee had to be someone important, otherwise they wouldn't be remembered as his sons.

However, being “children of important people,” carries with it the hazard of feeling entitled, like ... being seated at the right and left of Jesus.

We hear of course that when the other disciples heard of this request they became so indignant that Jesus had to stop and repeat the lesson that we have been hearing pretty much every Sunday for over a month, that in the Kingdom of God, the greatest are often the least and the least often the greatest.

So put aside the seating order and just be happy to be part of the group at all.

Some years back, a group of us here read most of the Dante's Divine Comedy. We got through Inferno, Purgatorio and most of Paradiso. Then Covid hit and we ended about three sessions of finishing Paradiso.

However, near the beginning of Purgatorio, Dante gave us a lovely scene of two choirs of Kings happily singing and praying, lined up along the sides of the Gate to Purgatory while the other once poorer souls entered ahead of them. These Kings were happy because they knew that they were saved, but “in life they were first and so now they had to content themselves to be last.” And so they had to wait.

Whoever has ears to hear ought to hear

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses:

Estamos en otoño y, como ya he escrito antes, esta parte del año litúrgico es bastante desafiante.

Las Lecturas Dominicales de este año se basan generalmente en pasajes del Evangelio de Marcos y nos recuerdan repetidamente que la perspectiva de Dios es diferente a la del mundo y que, con frecuencia, quienes creen que ven con claridad no lo hacen y quienes se quedan al margen, a menudo despresados, en realidad ven con más claridad que nosotros:

Hoy escuchamos el famoso pasaje en el que dos de los primeros cuatro discípulos de Jesús –Santiago y Juan, los hijos de Zebedeo– se acercan a Jesús con una petición un tanto arrogante: que cuando Jesús entre en su gloria, que se sienten uno a su derecha y otro a su izquierda.

Se ha observado a lo largo de los siglos que, dado que a Santiago y Juan se los suele llamar “los hijos de Zebedeo”, Zebedeo tenía que ser alguien importante, de lo contrario no serían recordados como sus hijos.

Sin embargo, ser “hijos de gente importante” conlleva el riesgo de sentirse con derecho, como... estar sentados a la derecha y a la izquierda de Jesús.

Por supuesto, escuchamos que cuando los otros discípulos oyeron esta petición se indignaron tanto que Jesús tuvo que detenerse y repetir la lección que hemos estado escuchando prácticamente todos los Domingos durante más de un mes, que en el Reino de Dios, los más grandes son a menudo los más pequeños y los más pequeños a menudo los más grandes.

Pues que dejemos de lado el orden de los asientos y simplemente alégrense de ser parte del grupo.

Hace algunos años, un grupo de nosotros aquí leímos la mayor parte de la Divina Comedia de Dante. Pasamos por el Infierno, el Purgatorio y la mayor parte del Paraíso. Luego llegó el Covid y terminamos unas tres sesiones antes de terminar el Paraíso.

Sin embargo, cerca del comienzo del Purgatorio, Dante nos dio una hermosa escena de dos coros de Reyes cantando y rezando alegremente, alineados a los lados de la Puerta del Purgatorio mientras las otras almas, que fueron más pobres, entraban delante de ellos. Estos Reyes estaban felices porque sabían que estaban salvados, pero “en la vida eran los primeros y por eso ahora tenían que contentarse con ser los últimos”. Y por eso tenían que esperar.

El que tenga oídos para oír, que oiga 😊

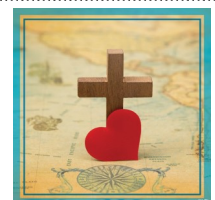
