PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we end our celebration of the Christmas Season with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

The Season began with our celebration of the First Octave of Christmas, which focused on the humanity of Christ and comprised of the Sol. of the Nativity of the Lord (Dec 25th), followed by the Sol. of the Holy Family (Dec 29th) and ended with the Sol. of Mary, the Mother of God (Jan 1st).

Last Sunday, we began our celebration of the Second Octave of Christmas, which focuses on the Divinity of Christ and begins with the celebration of the Sol. of the Epiphany of the Lord (Jan 5th this year) and ends today with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (Jan 12th this year).

Together the two Octaves along with a few days in between, spanning about 2 ½ weeks, allow us as Church to reflect on the Mystery of the Incarnation of Christ that: “the Word, which was with God and was God ... became flesh and dwelt among us” (John 1:1, 14).

But both these Octaves, and indeed each of the major feast days allow us to focus on matters particular to them.

Here we remember that while the Feast of the Epiphany with which we begin our annual reflection on the Divinity of Christ reminds us that God is capable of speaking to us in a manner particular to us – it would seem that only the three Kings saw the star that led them Jesus, others apparently did not see it or make the connection -- this Sunday, with the Baptism of the Lord, we remember that sometimes however, as in the celebration of the Sacraments, God makes himself manifest to all of us present.

The presence of the Lord in the Sacraments is something that I invite all to recall during our celebration of them in this “Year of Hope” that unfolds. And with this, I wish you all one last Merry Christmas. And may God bless us and protect us all in the coming year.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses,

Este fin de semana se acaba nuestra celebración del Tiempo de Navidad con la Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor.

La temporada comenzó con nuestra celebración de la Primera Octava de Navidad, que destacó la humanidad de Cristo y comprendió la Sol. de la Natividad del Señor (25 de Diciembre), seguido por la Sol. de la Sagrada Familia (29 de Diciembre) y terminó con la Sol de María, la Madre de Dios (1 de Enero).

El Domingo pasado, comenzamos nuestra celebración de la Segunda Octava de Navidad, que se enfoque en la Divinidad de Cristo y comienza con la celebración del Sol. de la Epifanía del Señor (5 de Enero este año) y termina hoy con la Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor (12 de Enero).

Juntos las dos Octavas, con algunos días intermedios, consisten de unas dos semanas y media, y nos permiten, como Iglesia, reflexionar sobre el Misterio de la Encarnación de Cristo: “la Palabra, que estaba con Dios y era Dios... se hizo carne y habitó entre nosotros” (Juan 1:1, 14).

Pero ambas Octavas, y de hecho cada uno de sus fiestas principales, nos permiten poner atención en sus temas particulares

Aquí recordamos que, si la Fiesta de la Epifanía con la que comenzamos nuestra reflexión anual sobre la Divinidad de Cristo nos recuerda que Dios es capaz de hablarnos de una manera que nos es particular –parecería que solo los tres Reyes vieron la estrella que los guió hacia Jesús, otros aparentemente no la vieron ni hicieron la conexión -- este Domingo, con el Bautismo del Señor, recordamos que, a veces, como en la celebración de los Sacramentos, Dios se manifiesta a todos los presentes.

La presencia del Señor en los Sacramentos es algo que invito a todos a recordar en este “Año de Esperanza” que se abre. Y con esto, les deseo Feliz Navidad una vez más, y que Dios nos bendiga y nos proteja a todos en el año que viene.


