**PASTORS PONDERINGS**

Dear Parishioners,

Before all else I want to thank Bishop Kevin Vann for coming to our Parish in an hour of need. A couple from our parish was deported leaving three small children behind. We don't know the politics, we don't know completely the circumstances but we can all imagine the children. Thank you Bishop Kevin for being Christ to us this past Sunday!

This Sunday we come to another classic Gospel episode proclaimed during Ordinary time – Jesus' call of the future St. Peter according to St. Luke.

In the version according to St. Mark, the episode was quick: Jesus just walked along the shore one morning, encountered the fishermen, Simon and Andrew, called them and they dropped everything and followed him (and likewise he called the brothers James and John a little further down the shore).

In St. Luke's version, there's more to the story: The future St. Peter and his brother had been fishing all night and had caught nothing. So when Jesus asks him for a favor: "Look at all these people, can you take me out in your boat a little ways off shore so that I could speak to them from a greater distance," the future St. Peter had perhaps another motivation – he didn't particularly want to come home. And we should be able to understand why: How does one come home gracefully, if after a whole night's work, one has nothing to show for it? Then, if this would have happened with some frequency, all the more so, it would have been increasingly hard to come home.

So the future St. Peter responds with saying essentially, "What the heck, why not?"

Then after Jesus' sermon, Jesus asks him to go out to deeper water and to cast his nets out there. One could imagine St. Peter rolling his eyes to himself: "The Preacher wants now wants to teach me how to fish." And then, with some sense of sadness, coming to appreciate: "What do I have to lose?"

The resulting miraculous catch becomes a superabundant answer to the future St. Peter's prayer, perhaps even a prayer that he wasn't even able to articulate on his own: "Go away from me, for I am a sinful man," the disbelieving future St. Peter is recalled as responding.

And yet in this episode is the Good News expressed in a kind and perfect way: God knows us, God knows what we need even before we ask.

What do we need today?

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

Antes de todo, quiero agradecer al obispo Kevin Vann por venir a nuestra parroquia en un momento de necesidad. Una pareja de nuestra parroquia fue deportada y dejó atrás a tres niños pequeños. No conocemos la política, no sabemos completamente las circunstancias, pero todos podemos imaginarnos a los niños. ¡Gracias, Obispo Kevin, por ser Cristo para nosotros el Domingo pasado!

Este Domingo llegamos a otro episodio clásico del Evangelio proclamado durante el tiempo ordinario: el llamado de Jesús al futuro San Pedro según San Lucas.

En la versión según San Marcos, el episodio fue breve: Jesús simplemente caminaba por la orilla una mañana, se encontró con los pescadores, Simón y Andrés, los llamó y ellos dejaron todo y lo siguieron (y de la misma manera llamó a los hermanos Santiago y Juan un poco más abajo en la orilla).

En la versión de San Lucas, hay más en la historia: el futuro San Pedro y su hermano habían estado pescando toda la noche y no habían pescado nada. Entonces, cuando Jesús le pidió un favor: "Mira a toda esta gente, ¿puedes llevarme en tu barca un poco más dentro del lago para poder hablarles desde más lejos?", el futuro San Pedro tenía quizás otra motivación: no tenía muchas ganas volver a casa. Y pienso que entendemos por qué: ¿Cómo se puede volver a casa sin preocupación, si después de una noche entera de trabajo, no se tiene nada que mostrar por ella? Y si esto hubiera sucedido con cierta frecuencia, con mayor razón, habría sido cada vez más difícil volver a casa sin nada en sus manos.

Entonces el futuro San Pedro responde diciendo esencialmente: "¿Cómo no?"

Luego, después del sermón de Jesús, Jesús le pide que vaya a aguas más profundas y que eche sus redes allí. Uno podría imaginar a San Pedro poniendo los ojos en blanco para sí mismo: "El Predicador ahora quiere enseñarme a pescar". Y luego, con cierta tristeza, llegando a apreciar: "¿Qué tengo que perder?"

La pesca milagrosa resultante se convierte en una respuesta superabundante a la oración del futuro San Pedro, tal vez incluso una oración que ni siquiera fue capaz de articular por sí mismo: "Aléjate de mí, porque soy un pecador", se recuerda como respondió futuro San Pedro.

Pero en este episodio la Buena Nueva se expresa de una manera cariñosa y perfecta: Dios nos conoce, El sabe lo que necesitamos incluso antes de que se lo pidamos.

Pues ¿Qué necesitamos hoy?

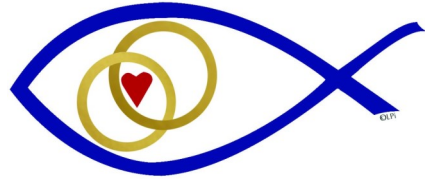
