PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

How things change? A week ago we were celebrating the 4th Sunday of Advent – a celebration where the Readings always underline the Holy Family if still expecting Jesus. This Sunday, an Octave later we celebrate the Holy Family after Jesus was born, and who was as children often are, at times surprisingly unpredictable.

The entry into the world, even our world, of a child or even more generally a new person, necessarily changes it.

On the other side, the child, or otherwise new person in a family, learns that a family, or community, or most generally the world existed before it.

On this Sunday in which we remember Jesus' humanity in the context of the very human family into which he entered, we recall that yes, he surprised his parents, and yes, he seemed to be surprised that the family had expectations of him that he might not have thought of before:

In the story we hear today, we hear that one Passover, when Jesus was twelve, he apparently stayed in Jerusalem without telling his parents, who then had to go back to look for him.

How many times similar misunderstandings happen in our lives, perhaps more often with adopted children, or in-laws marrying into our families?

Customs, traditions that had been set suddenly are challenged often by people just as surprised that they had done something unexpected as we were to see "time honored rules" not followed.

So on this lovely day, the second feast day of the First Octave of Christmas, which focuses on the humanity of Jesus, let us perhaps take some time to recall some of the more surprising or irritating members of our family, especially again from our in-laws or otherwise "blended" sides of our families, and appreciate that they too may have made adjustments that surprised them.

Then let us try to see in those surprises an invitation of our God to perhaps learn a few things new from our new and perhaps initially hard to understand members of the family.

They were created by God as well, and everyone has something to share. Happy Feast of the Holy Family!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

¿Cómo cambian las cosas? Hace una semana celebrábamos el 4º Domingo de Adviento, una celebración en la que las lecturas siempre ponen su atención a la Sagrada Familia, que todavía esperaba a Jesús. Este domingo, una octava más tarde, celebramos a la Sagrada Familia después del nacimiento de Jesús, y sí, quien fue como suelen ser los niños, a veces sorprendentemente impredecible.

La llegada al mundo, incluso a nuestro mundo, de un niño o, más generalmente, de una nueva persona, necesariamente lo cambia.

Por otro lado, el niño, o la nueva persona en una familia, aprende que una familia, o una comunidad, o, más generalmente, el mundo existía antes de él.

En este domingo en el que recordamos la humanidad de Jesús en el contexto de la familia muy humana en la que entró, recordamos que sí, sorprendió a sus padres, y sí, parecía estar sorprendido de que la familia tuviera expectativas de él que tal vez no se le hubieran ocurrido antes:

En la historia que escuchamos hoy, escuchamos que una Pascua, cuando Jesús tenía doce años, aparentemente él se quedó en Jerusalén sin decirle a sus padres, quienes luego tuvieron que volver a buscarlo.

¿Cuántas veces ocurren malentendidos similares en nuestras vidas, tal vez más a menudo con hijos adoptados o con parientes políticos que se casan con miembros de nuestras familias?

Las costumbres, las tradiciones que se habían establecido de repente son desafiadas a menudo por personas tan sorprendidas de haber hecho algo inesperado como lo estuvimos nosotros al ver que no se seguían las "reglas consagradas por el tiempo".

Así que, en este hermoso día, de la segunda fiesta de la Primera Octava de Navidad, que se centra en la humanidad de Jesús, tomémonos un tiempo para recordar a algunos de los miembros más sorprendentes o irritantes de nuestra familia, especialmente de nuestros suegros o de las familias se "mezclaron" en manera con nosotros, y apreciamos que ellos también pueden haber hecho ajustes que los sorprendieron.

Luego, tratemos de ver en esas sorpresas una invitación de nuestro Dios a aprender algunas cosas nuevas de nuestros nuevos y quizás inicialmente difíciles de entender miembros de la familia.

Ellos también fueron creados por Dios, y todos tienen algo que compartir. ¡Feliz Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia!

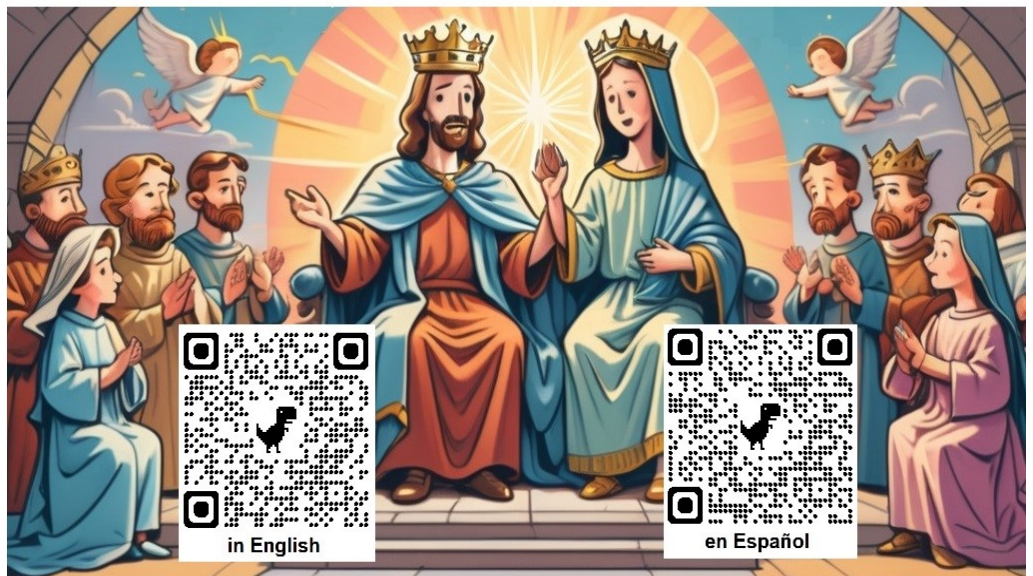
